IBM WebSphere Cast Iron is a highly versatile product that can function as an on-premise physical or virtual appliance, or as a full cloud service. It does not require programming, but provides an interactive development environment (IDE) that enables a developer to perform data mappings between a wide variety of application endpoints.

Cast Iron can perform data migrations and be used as an integration platform; it can provide and consume services; it can get and store information in disparate databases; and it can execute transactions in an ERP system.

Parke Cummins has worked in the IT industry for over 25 years. He joined IBM in 1983, working in the roles of developer for the IBM System i and as a Systems Engineer. Since he began working with CIBER in 1997, he has focused on IT infrastructure in support of ERP implementations for nearly 100 customers.
