### SPEAKER -Laura Calley IBM WW Program Manager - Power Certification

Laura Calley will be discussing IBM education and certification for the IBM POWER systems. Come to the meeting and learn about the education and certification that is available for the POWER systems and IBM i (what's available and where to get it).
