Glenn Haley, Senior Production Manager at Crossroads Systems, is a data security and storage professional who has spent more than 11 years defining and managing network security and data protection solutions. While at Hifn, Glenn helped to shape the direction of compression processing being used within tape drives and security processing within VPN based routers.
