### IBM i Application Development – Presented by Craig Nelson

IBM's re-branding the IBM i application development software (including WebSphere Development Studio) to Rational products can be confusing. We will explain the new packaging to help you determine which products you should choose top support your direction in software development.

- Are you using WebSphere Development Studio Client (WDSC)? You should come to find out which Rational product(s) you will need to replace it with.
- Are you developing applications using Java, Portal, SOA, or Web 2.0? You should come to find out what your Rational options are.
